**Gov. Rockefeller Proposes Highway Safety Program**

Governor Rockefeller, proposing a highway safety program with major emphasis on curbing the drinking river, called this week for "strong and prompt action" by the 1969 Legislature to reverse an accident trend that caused 3,117 deaths in New York State in 1968.

That toll, the Governor said, was an increase of 182 from 1967 and exceeded by 16 the record in 1931, when 2,101 died.

The Governor, in one of seven bills, recommended that it be made unlawful for anyone with a blood alcohol concentration of more than 0.16 per cent to drive a motor vehicle.

Under existing law, he explained, the presence of such an amount of alcohol is merely prima facie evidence, which may be considered by a court in deciding whether a person was "driving while intoxicated."

Penalties for the proposed new offense would be the same as those which face a person convicted under present law for driving while intoxicated.

These are a fine of up to \$500, a jail sentence of up to one year, and revocation of the driver's license, which may be restored only after six months or more. A second conviction, within ten years for driving while intoxicated is dealt with as a felony, carrying a penalty of up to \$2,000 fine and/or up to 2 years imprisonment.

Other bills recommended by the Governor include the following, which would:

—Authorize the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to require drivers to take written tests on rules of the road and fundamental principles of highway safety at license renewal time;

—Allow the Commissioner to require a new road test based upon the time elapsed since the prior road test, upon the licensee's age or upon his driving record;

—Require automatic license suspension for 30 days for a driver convicted of speeding 20 or more miles an hour above a speed limit of 50 or more miles an hour;

—Permit the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to include within the New York State "point system" for persistent violators any bail forfeitures in this state and convictions for "moving" traffic violations in nearby states;

—Give courts the authority to require a convicted traffic violator, as part of his penalty, to attend a driver improvement clinic conducted by the Department of Motor Vehicles or by local authorities; and

—Broaden the authority of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles to regulate the manufacture and sale of tires for passenger cars and trucks, including regrooved and retreaded tires.

The State vehicle inspection system now deals only with tread depth requirements.
