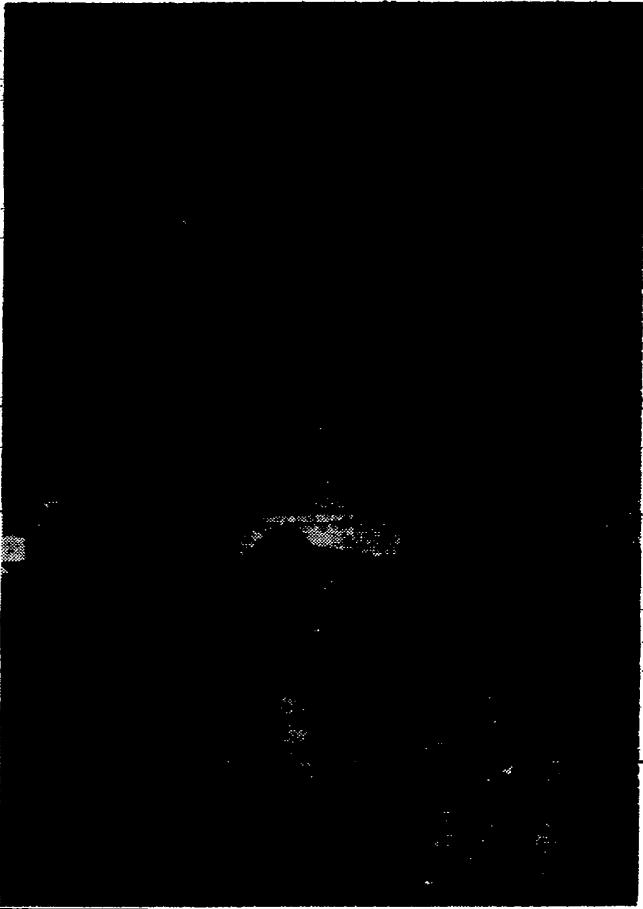

Does Your Auto License Expire This Month

The Department of Motor Vehicles has mailed some 800,000 of the renewal cards to car owners whose registrations expire at midnight Monday, March 31. Some owners may already have received them and others are on their way.

In the event the punch card has not arrived by March 15, owners should go to the nearest Motor

Vehicle issuing office and obtain a regular paper application. This may be substituted for the punch card application.

Owners also are reminded that they must have had their cars inspected since the last registration was issued.

If the new registration is not obtained by March 31, owners will have to provide new proof of insurance to renew, an FS-1 Form, from their insurance agent.
