**Attends College Book Store Assoc. Meeting**

Ronald Taylor of Andover, manager of the bookstore at State University Agricultural and Technical College, Alfred, participated in the first annual meeting of the College Store Association of New York State held in Syracuse March 26 - 28.  
Mr. Taylor was co-chairman of a workshop on "Services and Sources of Income for Your College Store". The newly-formed association is comprised of store people from about 70 colleges thru out the state. Other topics at the meeting included "Better Use of Space in Store Management", "Inventory Control", "Public Relations with Faculty, Staff and the Community", and "Pilferage Control".  
Mr. Taylor a 1960 graduate of Alfred State College, also completed the National Association of College Store Management seminar in Oberlin, Ohio.

**Almond Has Second Disastrous Fire**

The second disastrous fire in 18 months swept through the service garage of the McIntosh Implement firm in Almond last Wednesday morning, totally destroying the building and threatened several other structures nearby.  
Firemen said that sparks from a welding torch being used in the garage could have started the fire. Three other buildings nearby including the fire hall, were saved. The back of a garage owned by Fred Bayless, about 30 feet from the burning building, was scorched, but the Bayless home nearby was not damaged. Fire also melted tar from a composition shingle roof of a garage and burned away wiring to the auxiliary siren of the Almond Fire Department, whose building is located adjacent to the McIntosh firm on the west side of Main Street.  
The fire occurred across the street from the Palmer Block location, where a fire destroyed the three story frame building in Oct. 1967.

**Profits On Sale Of Home May Not Be Taxable**

Federal tax on any gain from the sale of a personal home may be postponed in some circumstances, said John E. Foley, District Director, Internal Revenue Service, Buffalo.  
Income tax on the gain will be postponed if the taxpayer buys and occupies another home that costs as much or more than the one he sold. Mr. Foley said the purchase of another residence should be made within one year before or after the date the old home was sold to qualify for the postponement privilege. Both the home sold and the home purchased must be the taxpayer's principal residence.  
Mr. Foley said that the profit on the sale of a personal residence can be entirely tax-free if the taxpayer is 65 or over at the time of the sale and certain conditions are met. There would be no tax to pay on a home sold for under \$20,000 if the taxpayer had owned and occupied the home for at least five of the previous eight years. For a home sold for over \$20,000 when these conditions are met, only a portion of the gain is taxable.  
Publication 17, "Your Federal Income Tax", is available at Internal Revenue offices at 50 cents a copy. The 160-page booklet, written in layman's language, covers in detail the Federal income tax laws as they apply to individuals.

Dr. James A. Taylor, an Illinois-based geographer and college administrator, has been named dean of Alfred University's College of Liberal Arts. Dr. Taylor is currently associate dean of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Bradley University, Peoria, Ill. His appointment at Alfred will take effect August 1.  
Ralph Dille, associate professor in the Department of English and the Honorable at State University Agricultural and Technical College at Alfred, will participate in a national conference on College Composition and Communications. The conference will be held April 14 - 19 in Miami, Fla. He will also assist in a presentation on "Use of Film in the Teaching of Composition." Prof. Dille, who has been a member of the Alfred State College faculty since 1966, is listed in the fifth edition of the Directory of American Scholars. Prof. Dille resides on Pingrey Hill in Andover.

Ground was broken Monday for construction of a new motor banking system that will provide the First Trust Union Bank of Wellsville customers with four-lane access to a modern drive-in facility. Board Chairman Carl E. Reuning of First Trust said that the new facility is expected to be completed by Sept. 15. The present drive-in will be removed to make way for the new building, but there will be no interruption of drive-in service for customers.
