Second Annual N.Y.S. Calf Sale May 1

The Second Annual New York State Calf Sale, sponsored by the New York State Holstein-Friesian Association, will be held at the former Cortland County Fairgrounds, Cortland, New York, on Thursday, May 1, 1969 at 7:00 P. M.

According to Francis Meehan, Rexville, N. Y., Holstein breeder and Sales Chairman, the major purposes of the sale are to provide a market for project calves, to reduce grade dairymen to purebreds through purchases of young stock, and to provide commercial heifer growers with a quality source of stock as well as breeding stock for all registered breeders.

Although the minimum requirements for selection for the sale requires that the calf be in excellent health and from a dam that will produce 500 pounds fat and classify Good Plus or better, it has been shown that most breeders want to send only their best calves to this sale and that therefore, the quality is much higher than required. Many of the dams of the calves have produced in excess of 20,000 lbs. milk and scored in the high "Very Good" range. In addition, nearly all are from leading A.I. sires and have good strong pedigrees through out.
