Ninth Annual Navigation Law Enforcement Seminar June 3 Through 6

The Ninth Annual Navigation Law Enforcement Seminar will be held June 3 through 6 according to James J. O'Brien, Director of the Conservation Department's Division of Motor Boats. Representatives of marine patrol units in every part of the state will gather in Poughkeepsie at that time to brush up on the latest techniques of law enforcement and water safety in anticipation of the 1969 boating season.

With their class rooms in the boat house of the Hudson River State Hospital, the marine officers will undergo a series of sessions covering every aspect of their duties from first aid and water safety to intensive study of new laws and water rescue procedures.

Conducting the courses will be members of the American National Red Cross, the U.S. Coast Guard local judicial officers, experienced marine patrolmen and specialists in several fields of concern to the officers.

In charge of the seminar will be L. James Flowers, Chief of the Bureau of Navigation Law Enforcement, Division of Motor Boats, and his staff. Dutchess County Sheriff Lawrence M. Quinlan will be the host to the participants.
