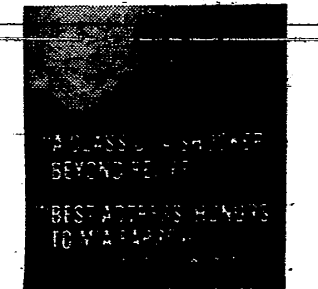
Baker Reunion
