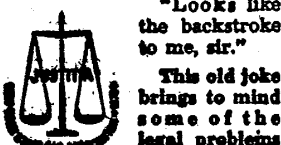

LIVING UNDER LAW

A FLY IN THE SOUP
"Walter, what's this fly doing in my soup?"



"Looks like the backstroke to me, sir."

This old joke brings to mind some of the legal problems created by what are termed "foreign objects" which are sometimes found in foods.

You'd be angry if a restaurant served you soup that had a fly in it. Few recipes call for such ingredients, so the fly would be termed a foreign object.

Other foreign objects could include broken glass, a bottle cap, and some bones.

The general test of whether an object you find in your food is truly "foreign" is whether the object may naturally be found there, or if it is supposed to be there.

When crunching down on a mouthful of popcorn you expect—but are generally pained—if it contains an unpopped kernel. Normally, you expect to find such kernels in the popcorn box, so such a kernel would not generally be classed as a foreign object.

However, if you buy a can of boned chicken, you should not expect to find any bones in it. A bone in a product which is supposed to be boneless would normally be a foreign object—you didn't expect to find it there. You might be able to collect damages if the bone injured you.
