Rev. George W. Tubbs and Mrs. Paul L. King To Speak At Andover Christian And Missionary Alliance Church

A missionary whose first assignment to China in 1946 was interrupted by the Communist occupation causing his transfer to Laos, will come here to speak in a missionary conference.

He is the Rev. George W. Tubbs, whose two year's tour through from his foreign missionary work in southeast Asia. Living in a mountainous area of Laos, most of his travel in carrying on his work and ministry was either on foot, or by horse or elephant. Due to the current war situation, overland routes are now closed and necessary travel is by airplane.

Mr. Tubbs will be one of the guest speakers during the annual missionary convention in the Christian And Missionary Alliance Church located at 5 Rochambeau Ave., Andover, New York. Dates of the special missionary emphasis are October 2 - 5. The public is invited to all of the sessions, which begin daily at 7:30 p. m., and at 11:00 a. m. and 7:30 p. m. on Sunday.

From 1955 to 1965, Mr. Tubbs ministered in Sayaboury province in North Laos, his "parish" stretching 200 miles along the western banks of the Mekong river and bordering on Thailand.

Engaging in evangelistic work and conducting short term Bible schools, Mr. Tubbs reported that the unsettled conditions in Laos did not hamper his ministry during those years. There are large movements of refugees from other areas of Laos in Sayaboury, among them Christians who are carrying their witness to many new villages.

"We have seen many tribes-people destroy their spirit fetishes and turn to Christ", he reports.

Since 1965, the Tubbses have lived in Vientiane, the capital. He has been chairman of the Alliance work in Laos for four years. "The airplane is the only means of

reaching 80 percent of the Christians in the country", he said.

A young woman whose ministries to the Chinese masses on the island of Taiwan are simplified because she lived among the Chinese with her missionary parents will come to Andover to take part in a church missionary convention.

She is Mrs. Paul L. King, the daughter of Rev. and Mrs. William H. Holton, of Hong Kong, and she will also be one of the guest speakers at the Christian And Missionary Alliance Church in Andover, October 2 - 5. The public is invited to attend all sessions beginning daily at 7:30 p. m. and at 11:00 a. m. and 7:30 p. m. Sunday.

Mrs. King will describe the efforts of missionaries to reach the millions of Chinese-speaking persons in southeast Asia, Indonesia, and particularly in Taiwan, where the Republic of China has been carried on since the mainland occupation by the communist forces in 1949.

Mrs. King attended the Nyack College, in Nyack, N. Y., and the Swedish Covenant School of Nursing in Chicago. After her marriage, she took an intensive linguistic course at Drew University before sailing for Taiwan in 1964 to take up the missionary career with her husband.

Although there has been a Protestant church in Taiwan for more than 100 years, the island can still be called a pioneer mission field. Mrs. King points out. This assessment is made because of vast segments of the population that remains untouched by the Christian message.

The Kings live and work in a heavily populated suburb of Taipei, the capital city, and are engaged primarily in direct church work and evangelism.

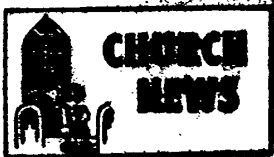
