NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by law, I shall on the 28th day of November, 1969, at 1:00 o'clock P. M., at the Court House in the Town of Amity, commence selling at public auction, so much of each of the said several and respective lots, tracts, pieces or parcels of land as shall be sufficient to pay all State, County, Highway, School, or other taxes assessed and levied thereon in the year 1968, that may then remain due on each thereof, respectively together with the interest, cost and charges which have arisen or accrued or that may arise or accrue thereon, and shall sell and continue from day to day to sell until the said sale shall be completed.

### Wellsville Firm Awarded Contract

The L. C. Whitford Company, Inc., of Wellsville has been awarded a \$269,487 contract covering a Farm Equipment Storage and Repair Shop at the State University Agricultural and Technical College at Alfred, Governor Rockefeller has announced.

The subcontractor for electrical work is Angelo Cilano, Inc., of Arkport; for plumbing, heating & ventilating, Stebbins Plumbing & Heating of Wellsville.

The facility, designed by the architects Faragher and Macomber of Rochester, brings students into contact with machines used in farming practice. It provides space for repair instructions, repair maintenance and storage of farm machinery. Hazardous conditions have been reduced to a minimum in the design, as students will be trained in the operation of the machinery.

The new building is a brick and block structure lying on the principal access to the College, as well as the University, and the town of Alfred. It relates to existing
