paying their tax, Mr. Foley said. Destinated tax forms. in a seprate package, will reach farmers and fishermen about the same date. In previous years, the estimated tax forms were included in the income tax package.

Farmers and fishermen have a choice of filing dates: They may elect to file and pay in full an estimated tax declaration by Janu ary 15, 1970 and file an income

tax return by the April 15 deadline; or they may elect to file only an income tax return by February 16 and pay the tax due with the return.

Like the other 77 million taxpayers expected to file tax returns in 1969, farmers and fisherman will be using the new income tax form 1040.

The form, which replaces both the old form 1040 and the 1040A

is a one-page, basic form to which separate schedules can be added to cover any tax situation.
