Legal Notice

COUNTY OF ALLEGANY A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Allegany as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary of the County Judge shall be the sum of Twenty-nine thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$29,150.-

SECTION 2. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Social Services shall be the sum of Thirteen thousand One hundred forty dollars (\$13,140.00).

SECTION 3. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary of the County Superintendent of Highways shall be the sum of Eleven thousand dollars (\$11,-

SECTION 4. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary of the County Treasurer shall be the sum of Eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000.00).

SECTION 5. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary for each Commissioner of Elections shall be One thousand seven hundred and sixty dollars (\$1,-760.00)

SECTION 6. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary of the Commissioner of Jurors shall be One thousand two hundred and seventy dellars (\$1,270.

SECTION 7. Commencing January 1, 1970, the annual salary for each Commissioner of Civil Service shall be Six hundred and sixty dollars (\$660.00).

SECTION 8. Commencing January 1, 1970, the compensation for county corners shall be at the rate of ewenty-seven dollars and fifty cents (\$27.50) perdiem in the performance of their official duties.

SECTION 9. This local law which is subject to permissive referendum shall take effect upon the date it is filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

Reports Due For Big Game Hunters

With the 1969 big game season now just a happy memory in New York State (with the exception of the bear season which ran until December 17 in some Catskill Counties), the State Conservation Deportment today urged hunters December 17 in some Catskill Counties), the State Conservation Department today urged hunters to submit all required report forms as soon as possible. The information collected from these report forms makes it possible to accurately determine the amount of game taken, the hunting pressure and the rate of hunter success. This infernation, along with other data, is used in setting future season guidelines.

The reports required of hunters include the following:

1. Big game report cards. Any big game hunter who took either a bear or a legally antlered deer (with antlers three inches or longer) must submit the report form which is a part of the big game license. Hunters who took neither a bear nor a antlered buck do not have to submit this report.

2. Party permit report form. All party permit leaders, whether their party took a deer or not, even if they did not hunt for a party permit deer must submit the report form which is printed on the back of their party permit arm band.

3. Special antlerless deer per-

on the back of their party permit arm band.

3. Special antierless deer permit report. Again, all hunters who received a special antierless deer permit fer use in the Moose River Recreation Area must report, whether they took a deer with the permit or not and whether they hunted the area or not.

Instructions for completing the report forms are shown on each form. Any hunter who needs help may call the regional office of the Division of Fish and Wildlife or his nearest Conservation Officer.

Potatoes should be stored in a sool, dark shee to prevent greening, sprouties and shriveling.
