News Briefs Of Local Servicemen

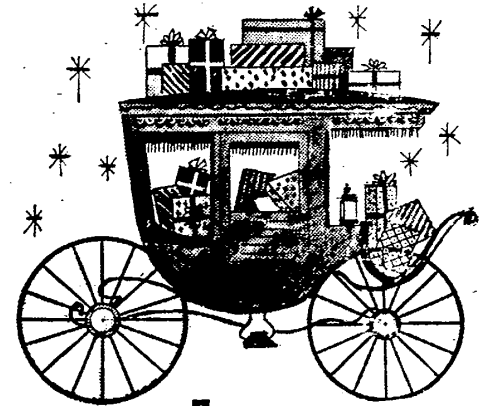

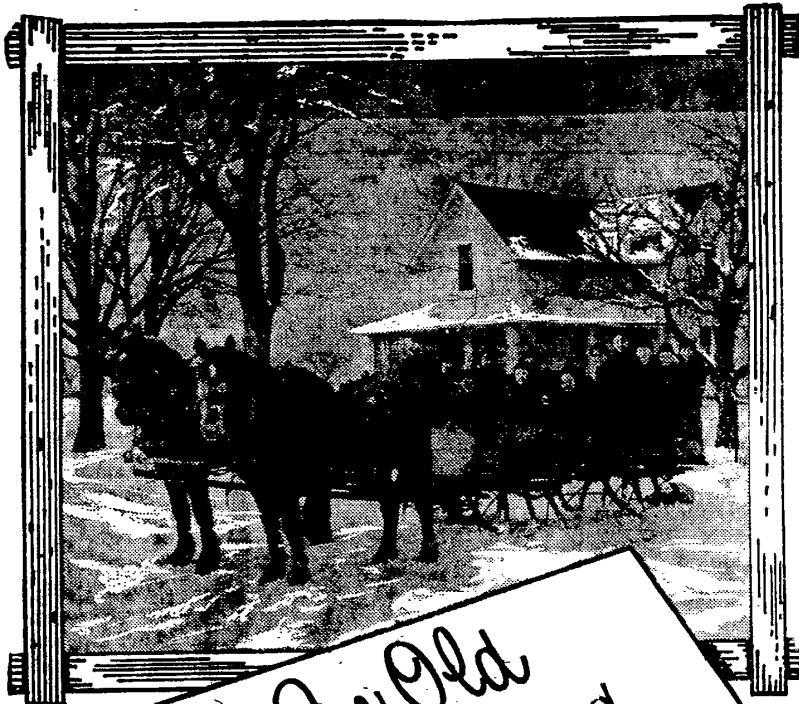
