 Andover Central School**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the annual meeting of the inhabitants of Central School District No. 1 of Andover, Allegany County, qualified to vote at school meeting in said district will be held at the school house in said district on Tuesday, July 13, 1971 at 8:00 o'clock p. m., for the transaction of such business as is authorized by the Education Law.

And notice is also given that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required for the ensuing year for school purposes exclusive of public monies, may be obtained by any taxpayer in the said district during the seven days immediately preceding the annual meeting except Saturday, Sunday or holidays at each of the following schoolhouses in which school is maintained during the hours designated:

Andover Central School, 9 - 12 a. m. and 1: - 4 p. m.
 And notice is also given that petitions nominating candidates for the office of members of the board of education must be filed with the clerk of the district not later than June 28, 1971.

The following vacancy is to be filled on the Board of Education:

Term: Five years (name of last incumbent: Mary K. Slade)
 Term: Two years (Name of last incumbent: Alan Tuttle)

Each vacancy requires a separate petition to nominate a candidate to each separate office. Each petition must be directed to the clerk of the district, must be signed by at least twenty-five qualified voters of the district, must state the name and residence of the candidate and must describe the specific vacancy for which the candidate is nominated including at least the length of the term of office and the name of the last incumbent.

Resolved, that the Board of Education of Central School District No. 1, Town of Andover, Alfred Wellsville, Independence and Ward, Allegany County, is hereby authorized and directed to purchase one school bus and expend therefor a gross sum not exceeding sum of 10,968.13 and that there shall be applied to the purchase any trade-in allowance to be received for a bus now owned by the school district and that the afore said total sum of \$10,968.13 or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by tax on the taxable property of the school district to be collected in annual installments; and further resolved that the Board of Education is authorized to issue obligations of the district therefor in accordance with the Education Law and Local Finance Law.

Proposals shall be made and received upon the following conditions:

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient sureties to be approved by the County Attorney in the sum equal to ten per centum (10%) of the amount bid, such bond conditioned that if the proposal is accepted, the successful bidder will enter into a contract for the work and that he will furnish, within fifteen (15) days from the date of the acceptance of the proposal, a performance bond in the amount of the contract, conditioned for the faithful and prompt performance and completion of the work specified in the contract and as required by the specifications.

All bid proposals shall remain open for a period of 30 days from July 7, 1971.

All deposits, except that of the successful bidder, will be returned. Upon acceptance of his bid, if the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract pursuant to the requirements, or fails to give the further security prescribed in this notice, within the time limited therein, then payment of the bond shall be enforced for the benefit of the County as liquidated damages. All proposals shall be in strict accordance with bid requirements as contained in the Specifications. The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids as permitted by law.
