Taxpayers Ask IRS

The column answers questions most frequently asked by taxpayers.

Q)I waited until April 15 be-fore I filed my return. How long will it take for me to get my re-

A) if there are no mistakes on a return to delay processing, it normally takes four to six weeks after a return is filed. It might take a little longer to get your refund, however, due to the large volume of returns filed in April.

Q) My farm workers would like me to withhold income tax from their wages this year... Can I do

A) Federal income tax may be withheld from a farm worker's wages if the worker requests it and if the employer agrees. Federal income tax may be

Note that withholding on farm workers is not mandatory. The election to withhold is optional for both employer and employee. Form W-4 should be used by the employee to request withholding.

Q) I have just sold my home at a profit. What are the tax conse-quences?

....A) The tax on any profit from selling your old home is postponed if, within a year before or after making the sale, you buy and occupy a new residence costing as much or more than the "adjusted sales price" of your old residence.

If you are 65 or over before the If you are 65 or over before the date of sale and have owned and occupled the property as your principal residence for at least five years of the eight years before the sale, you may choose to treat any profit as tax free if the adjusted selling price is \$20,000 or less. You may treat a proportionate part of the profit as tax free if the adjusted sale price is more than \$20,000. This choice to exclude profit on the sale of a residence from gross income can be made only once in a life-time.

Q) What interest do you charge a taxes that are not paid when

A) Interest at the rate of 6 percent is assessed from the date the tax is due until it is paid. In addition, a penalty of one-half of one percent is imposed for each month, or part of month, beroad the due date that the tax remains unpaid, up to a maximum of 25 percent.

If an extension of time for filling

If an extension of time for filling has been granted, the late penalty will not be applied for the period of the extension However, interest still will be charged from the date the text to due. the tax is due.

Q)I have first opened my own usiness. How do I get an Em-loyer Identification Number?

A) Use Form SS-4 to apply for your E. L. manies. This form is available from your local IRS office or the hearest office of the Social Security Administration. The completed form should be filed with the IRS office designated in the instructions. instructions.
