**Taxpayers Ask IRS**

This column of questions and answers on federal tax matters is provided by the local office of the U. S. Internal Revenue Service and is published as a public service to taxpayers. The column answers questions most frequently asked by taxpayers.

Q: I waited until April 15 before I filed my return. How long will it take for me to get my refund?

A) If there are no mistakes on a return to delay processing, it normally takes four to six weeks after a return is filed. It might take a little longer to get your refund, however, due to the large volume of returns filed in April.

Q) My farm workers would like me to withhold income tax from their wages this year. Can I do this?

A) Federal income tax may be withheld from a farm worker's wages if the worker requests it and if the employer agrees.

Note that withholding on farm workers is not mandatory. The election to withhold is optional for both employer and employee. Form W-4 should be used by the employee to request withholding.

Q) I have just sold my home at a profit. What are the tax consequences?

A) The tax on any profit from selling your old home is postponed if, within a year before or after making the sale, you buy and occupy a new residence costing as much or more than the "adjusted sales price" of your old residence.

If you are 65 or over before the date of sale and have owned and occupied the property as your principal residence for at least five years of the eight years before the sale, you may choose to treat any profit as tax free if the adjusted selling price is \$20,000 or less. You may treat a proportionate part of the profit as tax free if the adjusted sale price is more than \$20,000. This choice to exclude profit on the sale of a residence from gross income can be made only once in a life-time.

Additional information can be found in IRS Publication No. 523, "Tax Information on Selling Your Home." This publication can be obtained free by sending a post-card to your local IRS office.

Q) What interest do you charge on taxes that are not paid when due?

A) Interest at the rate of 6 percent is assessed from the date the tax is due until it is paid. In addition, a penalty of one-half of one percent is imposed for each month, or part of month, beyond the due date that the tax remains unpaid, up to a maximum of 25 percent.

If an extension of time for filing has been granted, the late penalty will not be applied for the period of the extension. However, interest still will be charged from the date the tax is due.

Q) I have just opened my own business. How do I get an Employer Identification Number?

A) Use Form SS-4 to apply for your E. I. number. This form is available from your local IRS office or the nearest office of the Social Security Administration. The completed form should be filed with the IRS office designated in the instructions.
