The Misses Sandra Hunt and Susan Wallace played a trumpet duet at the United Methodist Church Sunday, accompanied by Mrs. June Rollins.

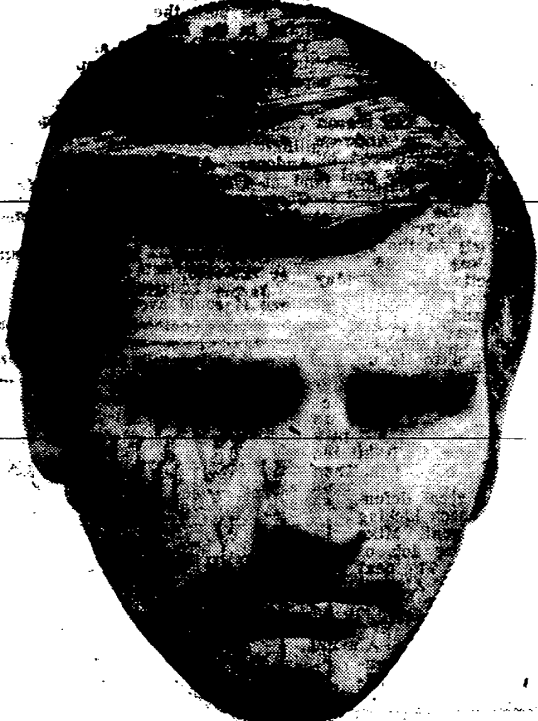
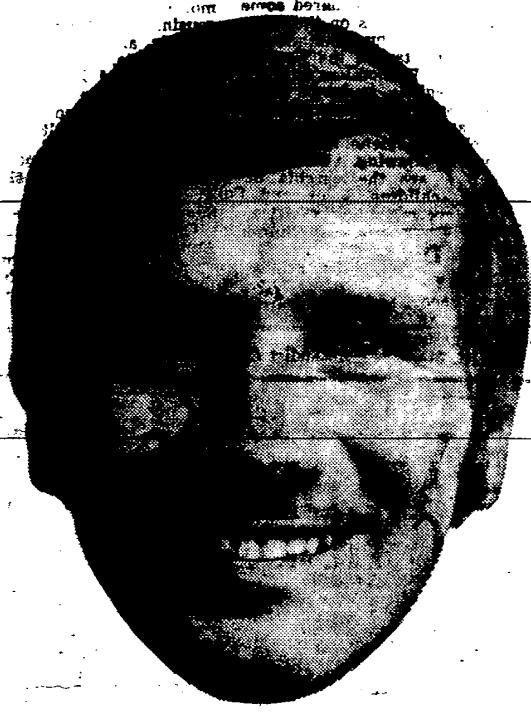
