NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by law, I shall on the 26th day of November, 1971, at 1:00 o'clock P. M., at the Court House in the Town of Amity, commence selling at public auction, so much of each of the said several and respective lots, tracts, pieces or parcels of land as shall be sufficient to pay all State, County, Highway, School, or other taxes assessed and levied thereon in the year 1970, that may then remain due on each thereof, respectively together with the interest, cost and charges which have arisen or accrued or that may arise or accrue thereon, and shall sell and continue from day to day to sell until the said sale shall be completed.

piration of one year from the last day of such sale, they shall be entitled to receive conveyances of the lands so purchased by them respectively, (or at their option foreclose the lien as provided by law) unless said lands shall have been previously redeemed, pursuant to law. 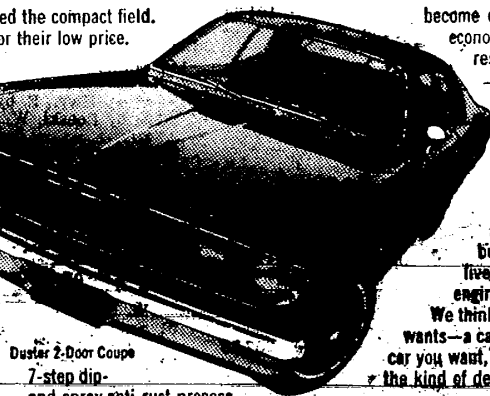
