Notice Of Special Village Election

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, duly adopted the following resolution calling a special Village election to be held on the 8th day of December, 1971, as therein described:

RESOLUTION DATED NOVEMBER 13th, 1971.

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL VILLAGE ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF ANDOVER, ALLEGANY COUNTY, NEW YORK, FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CERTAIN BOND RESOLUTION, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, has heretofore at this meeting duly adopted a bond resolution authorizing the construction of a sanitary sewer system to serve said Village; and further authorizing the issuance of \$1,560,000 serial bonds of said Village to pay the cost thereof, which resolution was adopted subject to approval at a special Village election in the manner prescribed in Article 5-A of the Village Law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 139-b of the Village Law, the Village Clerk, with the advice of the Village Attorney, has prepared and transmitted to this Board of Trustees a form of proposition for the approval of such bond resolution containing an abstract of such bond resolution concisely stating the purpose and effect thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to provide for the holding of a special election for the submission of such proposition and to provide for the notice of such election and other matters in connection therewith; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. A special election of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, shall be held on the 8th day of December, 1971, for the purpose of submitting the proposition as hereinafter set forth. The place of holding such election shall be at the Grange Hall, Greenwood Street, in Andover, New York, in said Village and the polls for such election shall be kept open for the purpose of voting by voting machine on such proposition between the hours of 12:00 Noon and 9:00 o'clock P. M., Eastern Standard Time.

Section 2. The proposition to be submitted at such special election shall be as follows:

PROPOSITION
 Shall the bond resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Andover, Allegany County, New York, on the 13th day of November, 1971, authorizing the construction of a sanitary sewer system, including a sewage treatment plant, to serve said Village at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,560,000 authorizing the issuance of not exceeding \$1,560,000 serial bonds of said Village to pay the cost thereof, subject to the provision that all State and Federal grants-in-aid received for said sewer system shall be applied in reduction of the amount of said bonds to be issued; determining that the period of probable usefulness is forty years, and that the maturity of said bonds will be in excess of five years; pledging the faith and credit of said Village to the payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and providing for an annual appropriation therefor; providing for the issuance of bond anticipation notes; containing an estoppel clause, and providing for the publication of an estoppel notice be approved?

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this resolution to be published once in the official newspaper of said Village and posted in accordance with the provisions of subdivision 5 of Section 4-228 of the Village Law.

Section 4. A person to be entitled to vote at said special election must be entitled to vote for an officer of said Village and must be registered in accordance with the provisions of subdivision 3 of Sec-

tion 7-702 of the Village Law. Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
