#### Local Law No. 8 of 1974

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law No. 8 of 1974 which became effective January 1, 1975, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING AN OFFICE FOR THE AGING IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established in the county government of the County of Allegany an office for the aging.

§ 2. The head of the office for the aging shall be a director who shall be appointed by the board of legislators of the county of Allegany and shall serve at the pleasure of said board.

§ 3. The purpose of establishing said office is to better provide for the needs of the aging in Allegany County.

§ 4. The powers and duties of said office shall be:

A. to provide policy and programmatic advice to Allegany county government and to all local governments in Allegany county on all aspects of said governments' responsibilities to its aging citizens

B. to plan and develop unified and coordinated county and community programs and policies with respect to the needs of aging citizens by utilizing county and community resources in the most efficient and productive manner;

C. to stimulate and review needed programs and services for the aging and search out all possible federal and state resources to assist in supplying the programs and services;

D. to operate programs and direct services that are appropriate to the purpose of the office; and

E. to exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by local law or by resolution of the board of legislators.

§ 5. This local law shall take effect on January 1, 1975.
