Local Law No. 1 of 1975
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law No. 1 of 1975 which became effective January 13, 1975, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A LOCAL LAW CREATING A TEMPORARY COUNTY COMMISSION TO STUDY YOUTH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES IN ALLEGANY COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a temporary county commission to be known as the temporary county commission on Allegany county youth, hereinafter referred to as the commission, to consist of seventeen members to be appointed by the chairman of the county board of legislators and serve at his pleasure. All of such members shall be residents of Allegany county, and at least eight of such members shall be under the age of 18 years. The commission shall choose from among its members a chairman, vice-chairman and secretary. Vacancies in membership of the commission occurring from any cause shall be filled by the chairman of the county board of legislators.

§ 2. The commission shall make a study of youth programs and services in Allegany county which shall include, but not be limited to, the documentation of present youth programs and services, the need of such present youth programs and services, the need of revising such present youth programs and services, the need of coordinating such present youth programs and services, the need of any new youth programs and services and whether a comprehensive plan for the provision of a board coordinated range of programs for the youth of Allegany county should be developed pursuant to subparagraph one of paragraph a of subdivision one of section 420 of the executive law.

§ 3. The commission may employ and at pleasure remove clerical, stenographic or technical assistants, or hire the same, as it may require and fix their compensation within the amount available therefor by appropriation.

§ 4. The members of such commission shall receive no compensation for their services, but shall be reimbursed for their expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties hereunder within the amount available therefor by appropriation.

§ 5. The commission may request and receive from any department, office, board, agency or instrumentality of the county and from any town, village or school district there in such assistance and data, as such entity may legally be authorized to reveal, as will enable it to properly consummate its studies hereunder.

§ 6. The commission shall request and receive on behalf of the county any state or federal aid which the county may be entitled to for undertaking such studies and deposit any such aid with the county treasurer.

§ 7. The commission may report from time to time and shall make a report of its proceedings and recommendations to the county board of legislators on or before the first day of August, 1975.

§ 8. This local law shall take effect immediately.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law No. 9 of 1974 which became effective January 1, 1975, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICERS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:
Section 1. The annual salaries, none of which include any earned longevity increment, of the incumbents of the county offices here in set forth shall be the amount herein set forth opposite each such office, to wit:

Office	Annual Salary
County Attorney	\$18,000
Commissioner of Social Services	16,500
Superintendent of Highways	16,000
Director of Planning	15,000
County Treasurer	14,000
Director of County Real Property Tax Service Agency	13,000
Public Defender	12,500
Commissioner of Elections	3,780

Section 2. This local law shall take effect on January 1, 1975; provided, however, in the event this local law is filed in the office of the Secretary of State after January 1, 1975, then, in such event, this local law shall take effect on the date of such filing.

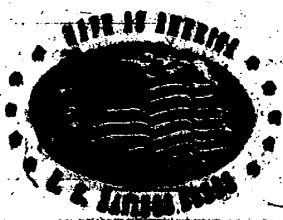
