Well Folks, the big news and buys this week is in the Florida Citrus line with low prices in both the red or white grapefruit with pineapple oranges and honey tangerines making their low price debuts for the first time this season. All of these citrus fruits can be purchased in case lots at big savings — so — stock up the refrigerator now.

In the vegetable line, '74 fall crop of potatoes remain at a lower price level than last year with a good supply still in storage. Iceberg lettuce remains steady but shipments of California asparagus are so light that it is a real high-priced item.

In the meat department, 3-legged fryers are being featured at less than 50¢ per pound this week with specials on bacon and pork chops going for less than \$1 per pound. Beef is still holding steady with slight increases in luxury cuts but special prices on the cheaper cuts such as chuck steak and roasts.

Onion sets are now in and on sale but it is understood that they are in short supply so if you want to be sure and get some for spring planting — now is the hour!
