GROCER NOT THE VILLARY

Consumer compaints over the rising food prices have focused on the food store because that is where the customer pays the bill. It's easiest to blame the grocer because he's the one who stamps on the higher prices. People forget that he may be changed higher prices by the time the food sets to him. to him.

An investigation by the Joint Economic Committee of Congress into food prices has exonerated food chains from the charge of profiteering. The probes found that food chain profits are "neither spectacular nor poor" when compared to other industries.
