DOUBLE "R" PIE

Pastry for two 8 inch pie crusts
1 lb. rhubarb, unpeeled (about
four cups)
1 cup honey
1 package (3 oz.) raspberry
gelatin
2 tablespoons cornstarch
1 egg slightly beaten
2 tablespoons butter

Line 8 inch pie pan with pastry.
Wash and trim rhubarb, do not
peel. Cut into 1/2 inch slices. Mix
with honey, dry gelatin, corn-
starch and egg. Spread in pie
shell, dot with butter. Adjust top
crust, sealing and fluting edge.
Cut slit for escape of steam. Heat
oven to 400°. Bake 35 minutes or
until nicely browned.
Note— Frozen rhubarb may also
be used (unthawed).

HONEY NOUGAT

(Start a day ahead)
1 cup honey
6 tablespoons light corn syrup
2 cups sugar
1 cup water
3 egg whites stiffly beaten
1 cup coarsely chopped
walnuts
1/2 cup cherries
1 teaspoon almond extract

Cook first four ingredients to
265° on candy thermometer.
Slowly add this syrup to egg
whites while beating. When the
mixture begins to stiffen add
cherries, walnuts and almond
extract. Pour into buttered cookie
sheet. Cover with waxed paper
and press down with flat object.
Let stand overnight. Cut in strips
and wrap in waxed paper. Or -
shape into balls; let stand
overnight, and dip in chocolate.

FROSTED HONEY EGG NOG

3 tablespoons honey
few grains salt
6 eggs
4 1/2 cups milk
3/4 teaspoon vanilla
nutmeg
Vanilla ice cream

Add honey and salt to eggs and
beat well with rotary beater, or
mixer. Stir in milk and vanilla.
Sprinkle with nutmeg. Float a dip
of ice cream on top of each
serving. Six servings.
