A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZATING THE CONSTRUCTION
OF A NEW COUNTY OFFICE
BUILDING TO BE ATTACH-BUILDING TO BE ATTACHED TO THE EXISTING COUNTY COURT HOUSE OFTHE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY, NEW YORK, AT A
MAXEMUM ESTIMATED
COST OF \$4,000,000, AND
AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING
\$3,800,000 SERIAL BONDS OF
SAID COUNTY TO PAY PART
OF THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Allegany County Board of Legislators of Allegany County, New York, as

Section 1. The construction of a new County office building to be attached to the existing County Court House of the County of Alle-Court House of the County of Allegany, New York, is hereby authorized at a maximum estimated cost of \$4,000,000, including grading or improvement of the site there of and original furnishings, equipment, machinery or apparatus required for the purposes for which such building is to be used.

Section 2. The plan for the fin-ancing of such maximum estimated-cost is as follows:
a) By the expenditure of \$200,000 available funds of said County hereby ap-propriated for such pur-pose, which amount shall pose, which amount shall constitute the down payment required by Section 107.00 of the Local Finance Law. Of such \$200.000 available funds, it is hereby determined that at least \$9,500 shall not be provided from revenue sharing forms. sharing funds, such amount snaring mands, such amount constituting at least five per centum of the local share of the portion of said County office building to be used for civil de-fense purposes, it being hereby further determined that the federal regulathat the federal regula that the federal regula-tions and provisions of law governing the expen-diture of revenue sharing funds do not permit the use thereof for the local share of projects in con-nection with which federal grants-in-aid are made available: and vailable: and

available; and
b) By the issuance of \$3,800,000 serial bonds of said County hereby authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to the Local Finance Law. It is hereby determined that there may be applied in reduction of the ultimate amount of serial bonds to be issued months of the count of revenue sharing or grants-in-aid.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probably usefulness of such specific object or purpose is thirty years, pursuant to subdivision 11 (a) (1) of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, it being hereby further determined that such building is to be of class "A" construction as defined in the aforesaid provision of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said County of Allegany. New It is hereby deter Scotton 3.

of said County of Allegany, New York, are hereby investigately pred-

ged for the payment of the prin-cipal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An amual ap-propriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said County a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisors of the Local Finance Law the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation makes in authorization of the antic or and to sen count anticipa-tion notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the County Tressurer the chief fiscal officer of such County. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner. as may be prescribed by said County Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

1) Such obligations are au-

thorized for an object or purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or 2) The provisions of law which should be compiled with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit of proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or lication, or

3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 7. This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in full in The Patriot and The Andover News, the official newspapers of such County, to-getter with a notice of the Clerk of the Allegany, County Board of Legislators in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
