NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the resolution published herewith has been adopted by the Allegany County Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany, New York, on the 28 day of April, 1975, and the validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object of purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

**BOND RESOLUTION DATED April 28, 1975.**  
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW COUNTY OFFICE BUILDING TO BE ATTACHED TO THE EXISTING COUNTY COURT HOUSE OF THE COUNTY OF ALLEGANY, NEW YORK, AT A MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$4,000,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$3,800,000 SERIAL BONDS OF SAID COUNTY TO PAY PART OF THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Allegany County Board of Legislators of Allegany County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The construction of a new County office building to be attached to the existing County Court House of the County of Allegany, New York, is hereby authorized at a maximum estimated cost of \$4,000,000, including grading or improvement of the site there of and original furnishings, equipment, machinery or apparatus required for the purposes for which such building is to be used.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of such maximum estimated cost as follows:

- By the expenditure of \$200,000 available funds of said County hereby appropriated for such purpose, which amount shall constitute the down payment required by Section 107.00 of the Local Finance Law. Of such \$200,000 available funds, it is hereby determined that at least \$9,500 shall not be provided from revenue sharing funds, such amount constituting at least five per centum of the local share of the portion of said County office building to be used for civil defense purposes, it being hereby further determined that the federal regulations and provisions of law governing the expenditure of revenue sharing funds do not permit the use thereof for the local share of projects in connection with which federal grants-in-aid are made available; and
- By the issuance of \$3,800,000 serial bonds of said County hereby authorized to be issued therefor pursuant to the Local Finance Law. It is hereby determined that there may be applied in reduction of the ultimate amount of serial bonds to be issued monies received from the Federal government on account of revenue sharing or grants-in-aid.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of such specific object or purpose is thirty years, pursuant to subdivision 11 (a) (1) of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, it being hereby further determined that such building is to be of class "A" construction as defined in the aforesaid provision of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said County of Allegany, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said County a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the County Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of such County. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said County Treasurer, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or
- The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
- Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 7. This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in full in The Patriot and The Andover News, the official newspapers of such County, together with a notice of the Clerk of the Allegany County Board of Legislators in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.
