An Editorial

On Saturday night, June 21st, 34 of you students were presented diplomas signifying the completion of the New York State requirements for graduation from High School. This marked the completion of at least 12 years of learning as prescribed by our educational standards.

It may also help you enlist in the branch of Armed Forces Military Service that you desire, or may even enable you to enter the college of your choice, depending on what type of diploma you received, and of course, your Regent marks.

However, your real Diploma will be in your personal folder which is kept on file for many years. This folder contains your total school record, your successes and failures together with your strengths and weaknesses. During the succeeding years many people, employers, investigation agencies and college representatives may inquire about your record.

Most of all you will be proud of your achievements, and your record will be of great assistance, while some — who have been content to merely "get by" will find some doors closed.

"Inside The State Capital"

One of the objections which many have voiced to the concept of a so-called 'year-round' legislative session goes something like this: "The longer you keep those people in Albany, the more money it's going to cost the taxpayers of this state." Although there may be some strong arguments in favor of the year-round concept, it would appear that with the Democrats in control, the taxpayers could well be poverty-stricken if things don't come to an end there soon.

The Assembly Minority Ways and Means Staff, which thus far in 1975 has been right in the button with its projections and analysis of this State's fiscal picture, look out the red pencils again recently and did some figuring on how much the Democratic-controlled Assembly will have asked for in taxes by the time we recess sometime in the next few weeks. Based on the projected passage of nearly \$400 million in new taxing authorization for Assembly-approved New York City by Assembly Democrats probably by the time you read this, the total will be \$774 million. The compilation of how they arrived at this figure is listed below as follows:

It should be noted that the entire proceeds of the Stock Transfer Tax from the State of \$104 million would go to New York City. It is also well to remember that prior to the passage of the New York City tax package, all of these taxes authorized by the Assembly have been passed with only Democratic votes and not a single Republican vote. And none of the taxes listed here passed the Senate.

The irony of all this lies in the fact that Governor Carey openly admitted several weeks ago that this State could and would survive this year without the massive increases which he had been advocating since January. Furthermore, new studies by the Minority Ways and Means staff have shown that not only are new taxes unnecessary for the current 1975-76 fiscal year, but projected revenue estimates would seem to show no need for new taxes in fiscal 1976-77 as well.

A report to Republican Minority members by Assemblyman Willis H. Stephens, ranking minority member of the Ways and Means Committee, indicated a probable range of 1976-77 revenue increases of \$635 to \$632 million. The report continued: "Close control of spending can and should mean that that no new state tax increases will be needed if the current 1975-76 fiscal year, nor in the 1976-77 fiscal year ahead. This is good news for the state's taxpayers and helps assure that there will be a strong economic recovery in New York State." Thus the passage of these massive tax increases by Assembly Democrats has been an unnecessary exercise in futility.

Meanwhile, there is no doubt that some new tax authorization must be finalized for the City of New York. This is the annual task of the Legislature, but the size of those tax increases is the question here. The Republican-controlled Senate has told Mayor Beane that they feel the increases in the neighborhood of \$100 million should be sufficient if the would just do something to curtail the giant spending program in the City. The Mayor's staff threaten the loss of thousands of municipal employees, but this far there has been little evidence that this is anything but a threat.

Meanwhile, the New York City spending continues unchecked and Assembly Democrats continue to

propose legislation which is completely contrary to fiscal prudence. This New York City tax situation must be resolved before we leave Albany for the summer, but I for one am unwilling to authorize one red cent of taxing power to the City administration. The one concrete evidence that the City administration is taking reasonable steps (and that doesn't mean firing those in essential services such as policemen and firemen) to correct its own fiscal crisis.

EMERY SCORES CAREY ON TOWN ROAD FUNDS LIMIT

Assemblyman James L. Emery has sent a letter to Governor Carey expressing his disappointment that the Governor is attempting to limit state funds for the town roads rebuilding project known as the Donovan Road Plan. At the same time Mr. Emery has invited the Governor to tour the 196th Assembly District and see the results of town road work under funds authorized by the plan in previous years as well as deteriorated roads in need of repair.

In the letter dated June 16, Assemblyman Emery noted that the program was originally begun under the leadership of Senator Austin Egan of Genesee and was known for years as the Egan Road Plan. "Rebuilding of roads in rural communities was deemed a necessity to get produce from rural areas to the cities and the program was dubbed the 'farm to market' program," he wrote.

In the past several years, when the Republicans were in the Majority in both the Assembly and Senate, the legislation to provide state funds for the program was carried by Assemblyman Emery in the Assembly and Senator James Donovan in the Senate. Last year legislation authorized the State to fund these town road projects up to 40 per cent of their total cost with the rest of the money coming from the towns.

In his letter to the Governor, Emery said he was "greatly disappointed" that Mr. Carey has instructed the Division of the Budget to put a limitation on funds for Donovan Road projects. He wrote "I feel that this program has a high priority in the State and that the City of New York is not the only one who has a right to be considered for this program. I can only believe that you are not familiar with the importance of this program."

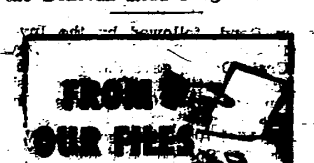
Emery urged you, and has so urged you, to visit the 196th Assembly District and view the outstanding work being done by the

town highway department crews rebuilding these roads and to also view the badly deteriorated roadways that are in need of repair. "I am sure you will agree that we should provide good highways to transport our children to and from school in safety, as well as moving farm products to market."

Meanwhile, Assemblyman Emery has sent a memorandum to all town officials in Albany and Livingston counties and the portion of Ontario County within the 196th Assembly District appraising them of the status of the Donovan Road project state funds. He noted that in April, 1975, legislators had been informed that these funds would be encountered with the Governor. Even though Governor Carey did not provide any increase in funds in the 1976-77 State Budget.

However, he has now found that the Budget request for the program was \$1.5 million while actual needs from various towns throughout the State are \$1.5 million. The Governor's Budget provided \$1.5 million. He further explained that the State Department of Transportation has put in a Supplemental Budget request for an additional \$1.5 million, but Governor Carey has refused that only \$3.8 million be available.

In his letter, Assemblyman Emery noted that the DOT is revising the program and that priority will be given to bridge projects in relation to town roads. However, he warned that town road projects involving Donovan Road funds should not be started without DOT approval unless the town is willing to finance the project without State assistance. He also assured the town officials that he would support a Supplemental Budget request for more funds for the Donovan Road Program.
