Local Law No. 3 of 1975

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN hat the following Local Law No. of 1975, which became effective uly 31, 1975, is published pursunt to Section 214 (2) of the County Law.

OUNT LAW. IN RELATION TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TEMPORARY
COMMISSION TO BE KNOWN
AS THE ALLEGANY COUNTY BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:
Section 1. There is hereby created a temporary county commission to be known as the Allegany county becentennial commission for the purpose of promoting and insuring a fitting and proper celebration within the county of Allegany of the bicentennial celebration of the United States of America.

\$ 2. Such commission shall have eleven members who shall be appointed by the chairman of the Allegary county board of legislators. One member shall be the Allegary county board of legislators. One member shall be designated as chairman by the chairman of the Allegany county board of legislators, and the county historian shall be an exofficio member of the commission. The members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties within the appropriation for that purpose. Vacancies on the commission shall be filled for the unission shall be filled for the unpurpose. Vacancies on the com-mission shall be filled for the un-expired term in the same manner as original appointments are made.

§ 3. Such commission shall have the power to cooperate with and lend assistance to the American Revolution bicentennial commission created by the congress of the United States and any similar committees or commissions created by the State of New York or any subdivision thereof to contribute to the successful celebration of the bicentennial celebration of the bicentennial celebration of the bicentennial celebration of the bicentennial celebration of the United States of America and to promote attend and participate in any and all functions or ceremonies within the county of Allegany held-to commemorate such occasion and to request and receive from all officers, departments and agencies of the county of Allegany such creperation and assistance as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the purpose of such commission. Such commission shall also exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by resolution of the county board of legislators.

§ 4. Such commission may expend on the such sums of money to effectuate its purpose as may be made

§ 4. Such commission may expend such sums of money to effectuate its purpose as may be made available by resolution of the county board of legislators in accordance with law. Such expenditures shall be payable by the Allegany county treasurer upon vouchers approved by the chairman of the commission and audited by the county board of legislators.

§ 5. Such commission shall re-port from time to time upon the progress of its work to the county board of legislators and shall also make such recommendations to the

make such recommendations to the county hoard of legislators as it deems fit in relation to the bicentennial celebration.

§ 6. The commission hereby reated shall expire on December 31, 1977, unless otherwise extended by the county board of legislators, Upon its expiration such commission shall file a final report of its activities with the county board of legislators.

§ 7. This local law shall take effect ammediately.

Written Exam For 🛫 NYS Trooper Sept. 20

NYS Trooper Sept. 20

Superintendent William G. Connelic of the New York State Police has announced the scheduling of a written competitive examination for the position of trooper to be held September 20 at 15 locations throughout the state.

Any person wishing to take the examination may obtain an application from any State Police station or by writing to the Director of Personnel, New York State Police, Building 22, State Campus, Albany, N. Y., 12226.

Applications must be postmarked no later than September 3.

When the completed application is received, applicants will be advised when and where to report for the written test and receive an admission card to the test location.

Candidates must be at least 20

admission card to the test location.

Candidates must be at least 20 years old on the date of the examination and must be between the ages of 21 and 29 at the time of an appointment. The maximum age of 29 may be extended up to six years for military service.

The basic requirements for a trooper include a high school or equivalency diploma. United States citizenship at the time of the examination, residency in New York State at the time of an appointment, a vasid New York driving license and a year's driving experience, and sound physical condition as determined by a medical examination prior to appointment. A conviction for a felony is an automatic bar to an appointment. The 4,000 applicants scoring

The 4,000 applicants scoring highest on the written test will be eligible to compete in the next phase of the examination process, the physical performance test. The next steps in the examination procedure are an oral interview. procedure are an oral interview and a background investigation of fitness,

fitness.

A competitive list will be established on the basis of a composite score of the results of the written test, 65 percent of the final score, and the physical performance test, 35 percent of the final score. Veteran's credits will be added to the final score as required by law to determine the final eligibitity list.

No appointments of troopers will be made before next April and the number eventually made will be determined by budget authorizations by the Legislature.

Locations for the written examination include: Albany, Bay Shore, Binghamton, Buffalo, Elmita, Glens Fails, Middletown, New York City, Olean, Plattsburg, Rochester, Syracuse, Utica, Watertown, Yonkers and other locations as determined by the volume of applications. volume of applications.
