## Use Salt, Soda, Ammonia

### Cleaning Tips From A Teacher

Salt, baking soda, vinegar and ammonia are a "homemaker's best friends." And procrastination is her greatest enemy.

So says the woman who teaches homemakers the art of keeping a home tidy with a minimum of fuss at the Minneapolis-St. Paul area vocational-technical institutes.



Unfurling three charts which were as impressive in size as in content, Mrs. Lois Millner emphasizes that no one should start housecleaning without a blueprint. She creates charts listing daily, weekly, monthly and seasonal housecleaning duties, followed by a time schedule.

Drawing on her 30 year career in housecleaning, Mrs. Lois Millner offers these hints to ease housecleaning chores:

—Windows and mirrors come sparkling clean with a solution of ammonia, vinegar and comfortable temperature water.

—A solution of vinegar and water will clean Formica counter tops. For stubborn stains, try dry baking soda and rub with dampened cloth.

—For stains that accumulate on china or ceramics, rub a paste of salt on the stains and close it off.

Mrs. Millner finds that 3M

Scotch-Brite scrubbers hold cleaning liquids better than brushes which tend to get soft and lose their scrubbing power.

The scrubbers consist of different colored abrasive scrubbing surfaces mounted on a styrene base with a handle for increased scrubbing power and are available in three grades, white for light-duty cleaning, blue for routine cleaning and black for heavy-duty jobs.

She uses a solution of ammonia and water and a heavy-duty scrubber to clean a messy barbecue grill.

A vinegar-soaked light-duty scrubber will clean soap and water spots from chrome bathroom and kitchen fixtures, she says.



Clean slate floors with a solution of ammonia and water and use a scrubber designed for routine cleaning.

To lick procrastination, Mrs. Millner recommends getting organized by developing a chart that lists all the household tasks to be done, followed by the amount of time to be spent on each task.
