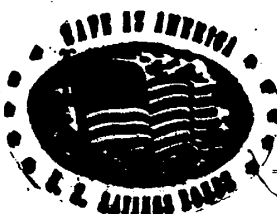

Local Law No. 4 of 1975

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following Local Law No. 4 of 1975 which became effective August 13, 1975, is published pursuant to Section 214 (2) of the County Law:

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NUMBER ONE OF NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE IN RELATION TO REPORTING TIME AND TERMINATION OF TEMPORARY COUNTY COMMISSION TO STUDY YOUTH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES IN ALLEGANY COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Allegany as follows:

Section 1. Section seven of local law number one of the year nineteen hundred seventy-five, entitled "A local law creating a temporary county commission to study youth programs and services in Allegany county", is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 7. The commission may report from time to time and shall make a report of its proceedings and recommendations to the county board of legislators on or before a date fixed by resolution of the county board of legislators. The commission shall cease to exist on a date fixed by resolution of the county board of legislators.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.

Veteran News

Many veterans become ill and use their life savings to pay for needed hospital care before they inquire as to their entitlement for admission to a Veterans Administration hospital, according to James J. McLaughlin State Veteran Counselor.

Medical and hospital care are very expensive today, and most people who are regularly employed are covered by some type of health and hospitalization insurance. In some instances veterans fail to realize that they may be eligible for care in VA hospitals even though they are covered by insurance.

Eligible for admission to any VA hospital is a veteran who was discharged or released from the active military service under conditions other than dishonorable. Medical emergencies always have first priority for admission, followed by veteran who require hospitalization because of a disability which was incurred during service.

Some veterans must show evidence of inability to pay for the needed care before they can be admitted. This is not necessary, however, if the veteran is seeking treatment for a service-incurred disability, if he is receiving VA disability compensation or pension, if he was released from service because of a service-connected condition, or if he is 65 years of age or older.

The counselor urged veterans seeking further information on VA hospitalization to visit the local counseling center of the New York State Division of Veterans' Affairs located at the City Building 108 Broadway, Hornell, New York.
