The Clergy Review

Psalm 69.4 "I restored that which I took not away".
"LESS SHALL BE LOST THAN WON"

For God maketh even the wrath of man to praise Him, and the remainder of wrath he doth restrain. The skeptic may ask sneeringly, "Why 'did God, righteous and omnipotent, ever permit sin to raise its hideous head in the universe, thus defiling the heavens and the earth?" But the work of the cross is the answer to it all. Man's relationship to GOD as a redeemed sinner is far greater, and more blessed than the mere relationship of creature to Creator. And the grace of God has been magnified in the great trespass offering of the cross in a way it never could have been known if sin had never come in at all.

How precious the WORD OF GOD, "The blood of Jesus Christ GOD'S SON cleanseth us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." I John 1:7b-9.

The preacher, Gipsy Smith, was heard to say to a big strong weeping man who said, "Oh, sir, my sin is too great ever to be forgiven." Quick as a flash the preacher said, "But His Grace is greater than all your sin."

It may be that those words are coming to some poor, anxious, troubled soul. Do you wonder sometimes if you have sinned beyond all hope of mercy? Oh, be persuaded, if you will but come to God bringing the trespass offering, that is, putting your heart's trust in the Lord Jesus, looking to Him alone for salvation, every sin will be forgiven; all that you have done will be blotted out forever, and be in God's sight as if it had never been. It is the truth of this that inspired the song writer Dr. Towner, to write and compose the grand old hymn that so graphically explains God's unmerited love "Marvelous grace of our loving Lord.

Grace that exceeds all our sin and our guilt.
Yonder on Calvary's mount out poured,
There where the blood of the Lamb was spilt,
Grace, grace, God's grace
Grace that is greater than all our sin.

As Jesus last word's were, "It is finished," His done, His done, the great transaction is done. Our text said, "I (Jesus the SON of God) restored that I took not away."

Let this be noted that the sin question is not one of resolution, but one of regeneration; not reformation but reconciliation.
