C. & M. A. Missionaries To Be Released

Dr. Nathan Bailey, President of The Christian and Missionary Alliance confirmed this morning receipt of a report that Alliance missionaries detained by the Provisional Revolutionary Government of Viet Nam will be released in late October or early November.

This report received from hours are considered and on announcement from Hanoi, North Viet Nam and verified by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees. It indicates that the missionaries will arrive in Bangkok, Thailand by way of Vientiane, Laos.

Dr. Bailey said, "We hope that the assurances we had previously received from the Provisional Revoution ry Govt. of Viet Nam, that our missionaries were being well cared for, will now be confirmed by their physical release." He added that the C.M.A. center in Bangkök is ready to receive the missionaries and to provide them with a place of rest and with any medical attention they may need be ore proceeding to the United States.
