Hi Folks, with the Ho, Ho, Ho, Season upon us, we have some wonderful meat specials that are really timely.

In the Meat Department, Wilson Corn King semi-boneless Ham is \$1.19 a lb. for the whole or half. Rib Half Pork Loin Roast is \$1.29 a lb.; Shenandoah Turkey Roast is 3 lbs. for \$3.29; 1st Cut Chuck Roast is only 89c a pound; and boneless Veal Leg Roast is \$1.49.

In the Grocery Department, Crisco is \$1.39 for a 3-lb. can; Hunt's Fruit Cocktail is \$1 for 3-15-oz. cans; Ragú Spaghetti is 88c for a qt. jar; Tetley Tea Bags are 99c for a 100 ct. pkg.; Braden Egg Nog is 69c for a quart; 7 Farms Ice Cream is 89c for a 1/2 gal.; and Hunt's Peaches are 39c for a 15-oz. can.

In the Produce Department, Red Emperor Grapes are 33c a lb.; Florida Tangelos are 49c a doz.; Yellow Cooking Onions are 49c for a 5 lb. bag; and Homegrown Cabbage is 12c per pound.
