The Andover Lions Club also distributed about 40 food baskets to some of our local shut-ins and residents, and also distributed many toys that were very worthwhile program.

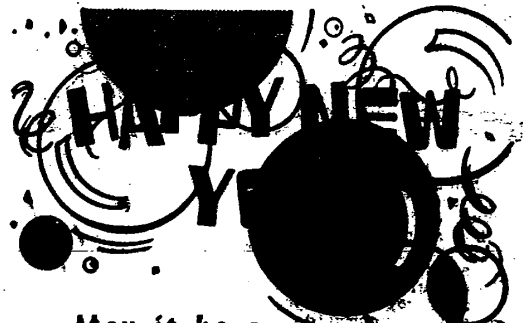
