

Tree Workshop Branches Out

TREE Workshop in Alfred, New York, Allegany County's only sheltered workshop, isn't waiting until spring to grow. TREE has received a Title VI grant to locate mentally and physically handicapped adults, sixteen and over, who could be benefitting for TREE's services — if only TREE could find them. To do this, TREE needs the help of the entire county community.

At TREE Training, Rehabilitation, Employment, Education, mentally and physically handicapped adults have a chance to earn money while they learn work and useful life skills which may help them get jobs and become more productive members of the community. Transportation to and from the Workshop is provided for a nominal charge.

FACT SHEET

WHAT: A county wide search for mentally and physically handicapped adults who are not now but who could be benefitting from a sheltered workshop situation.

WHO: TREE Workshop, Allegany County's only sheltered workshop in Alfred, New York, has received a Title VI grant for the specific purpose of locating mentally and physically handicapped adults in the county who perhaps at the present time are not receiving rehabilitation services.

WHEN: The project is to last nine months from October through June.

WHERE: The project is to cover Allegany County in its entirety.

WHY: Past efforts at locating mentally and physically handicapped adults in Allegany County revealed results inconsistent with the number of Workshop participants currently at TREE and the number of referrals TREE receives monthly.
