

**Harry F. Joyce**

Harry F. Joyce, 74, of 58 Chesnut St., Andover, N. Y., died Friday, December 15, 1978 at the St. James Mercy Hospital, Hornell, N. Y., after an extended period suffering from a rare and uncommon malady.

Born November 13, 1904, he was the son of the late Harry and Mary Brown Joyce. Prayer services were held at the James B. Mulholland Funeral Home on Monday, at 9:30 a. m. followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10 a. m. at the Blessed Sacrament Church of Andover with the Rev. Francis Zmoyzinski officiating.
