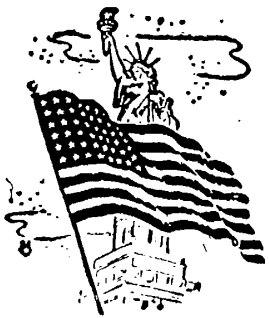
The public is invited to come and praise God for the Birth of Jesus.
